

Common Causes of Overheating

- **Faulty radiator pressure cap.**
- **Defective radiator.**
- **Bad thermostat housing gasket.**
- **Cracked or deteriorated radiator.**
- **Cracked or deteriorated heater hoses.**
- **Defective heater core.**
- **Faulty heater water control valve.**
- **Defective water pump seal or gasket.**
- **9Rusted out core hole plugs.**
- **Damaged coolant reserve tank.**
- **Bad cylinder head gasket.**
- **Cracked cylinder head, manifold or block.**
- **Low coolant level.**
- **Low coolant protection (low boiling point.)**
- **Water used as coolant (low boiling point.)**
- **Cooling system capacity inadequate for load being carried or towed.**
- **Air trapped in cooling system.**
- **Clogged coolant passage in engine block.**
- **Excessive use of A/C while vehicle is parked or in stop-and-go traffic.**
- **Retarded ignition timing.**
- **Sticking manifold heat control valve.**
- **Clogged exhaust system.**
- **Low engine oil level.**
- **Excessive engine friction.**
- **Dragging brakes.**
- **Missing or broken shroud.**
